**Deuteronomy 30.15-20** In the wilderness, the Israelites listen to their leader Moses who describes the people they have become. Before they enter the Promised Land, Moses gives them the stark choice that lies before them: love God and live, or serve other gods and perish.

**Philemon 1-21** This brief letter tells of a slave who came into contact with St Paul and how Paul then wrote to the slave-master to ask for the safe return of his runaway slave.

**Luke 14.25-33** Think carefully before you decide to follow Jesus and be prepared to sacrifice everything. Followers of Jesus were required to let go of all their possessions to focus their attention on God's call. Were they ready then? Are we ready now?
